## OREGON SYMPHONY'S WATERFRONT CONCERT

(PORTLAND, Ore.) – On September 3 at 7pm, All Classical Portland will provide for the first time ever, a live broadcast of the Oregon Symphony's beloved Waterfront Concert.

Tom McCall Waterfront Park will once again light up following Tchaikovsky's *1812 Overture*, complete with military cannons from the Oregon Army National Guard 218th Field Artillery. An expected audience of 20,000 will enjoy the largest free concert in the state, but now, audiences around the world can tune in to hear Suzanne Nance and Robert McBride host the show thanks to the radio broadcast and online stream provided by All Classical Portland.

Oregon Symphony President Scott Showalter acknowledged the special funding from the city of Portland: "Mayor Charlie Hales and the City Commissioners have our great thanks for funding the Waterfront Concert. We're also very pleased that All Classical Portland will broadcast the concert to its listeners around the globe."
