PORTLAND, Ore., May 6, 2011 – All Classical 89.9 FM will air the Oregon Symphony Orchestra's LIVE Carnegie Hall debut performance of *Music for a Time of War*. The two-hour concert takes place at 5 p.m. on Thursday, May 12, and is dedicated to the memory of Harold Schnitzer, one of Portland's most generous arts patrons who passed away April 27, 2011.

Part of the Spring Music Festival in New York City, the Oregon Symphony is one of seven orchestras chosen for the prestigious week-long event. On the program, conducted by Carlos Kalmar: Charles Ives' *The Unanswered Question*, John Adams' *The Wound-Dresser*, Benjamin Britten's *Sinfonia da Requiem* and Ralph Vaughan Williams' *Symphony No. 4*.

“This is one of those wonderful, rare, radio moments in time which makes us so proud of our Symphony and our community,” stated All Classical FM Program Director John Burk.
