On behalf of KBPS Public Radio Foundation ("KBPS"), this letter is written to notify the Commission of the commencement of digital broadcasting over the above-referenced facilities, using iBiquity Digital Corporation HD radio equipment. The following information is provided pursuant to the Commission's *Public Notice* on interim digital operations, DA 03-831, released March 20, 2003:

1. *Commencement Date:* June 16, 2005
2. *Certification of Facilities:* KBPS certifies that its facilities conform to the iBiquity Digital Corporation hybrid FM specifications.

Analog: 3880 watts
Digital: 45.9 watts
Total: 3925.9 watts

5. *Certification of ERP:* KBPS certifies that its analog effective radiated power will remain unchanged after commencement of digital operations.

6. *Radiation Exposure Certification:* KBPS certifies that its interim digital operations will not cause human exposure to levels of radio frequency radiation in excess of Section 1.1310 of the Commission's rules and are therefore categorically excluded from environmental processing pursuant to Section 1.1306(b) of the Commission's rules.
